May 2007 Meeting

Eleven members and four guests attended the April 16th meeting at the University Club. The Emmajean McDermott Scholarship recipients were introduced: Cerissa Griffin (Norman High) and Courtney Little (Norman North High)..

Treasurer Mary Joyce Hurst reported the Club funds as follows: Emmajean McDermott Scholarship principle – \$21,448.39; available balance – \$1,034.91; Sunshine Adkins CD of \$1,000.00, and the general checking account balance – \$1,137.42. She stated that the CD of \$1,600 had matured with \$600 moved to the general fund for awarding the Sunshine Adkins recipient. [Because one of the 2006 scholarship recipients did not attend OU, her \$500 check was voided with credit added to increase the amount of the scholarship funds.] Mary Joyce reported a \$33 check was received from National for dues.

Discussion was held on the garage sale. *Lisa McGoldrick* offered her garage (with a covered carport) for August. At the July meeting we will pick the date—once we know the date of the Norman All-City Garage Sale weekend. Lisa said at garage sales she has held in the past, she was open on Sunday; however, the main day for the Club would be Saturday.
